Undergraduate 4-year program

Program Description

Faculty of Science and Technology, Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya offers graduate programs in Thai traditional medicine in order to produce graduates in Thai traditional medicine who are able to apply knowledge and skills in traditional Thai medicine to their professional practice, have professional skills, communication skills and analytical management skills which can be used in developing knowledge in Thai traditional medicine. Moreover, the graduates are able to combine both Thai traditional and modern medicine to create the benefit to society and self-reliance on health.

The program consists of 4 main branches as follows:

- 1) Thai medicine:** It is about disease testing, finding the cause of the disease, treatment planning and drug formulation.
- 2) Thai pharmacy:** This is related to pharmacy object, properties, pharmacy and pharmaceutical properties (Thai traditional drug preparation)
- 3) Thai traditional midwifery care:** This involves caring for pregnant women and their babies from the antenatal to postpartum periods in normal process.
- 4) Thai massage:** It is about basic massage, royal massage, therapeutic massage and health service massage.

Applicants' Qualifications

1. Have graduated at least a high school certificate or equivalent with at least 22 credits in the subject matter of science, at least 12 credits of mathematics and at least 9 credits of English.
2. Be in good health, both physically and mentally, not sick, contagious or abnormal that could be an obstacle to education and / or registration as a professional practitioner in the field of Thai traditional medicine.
3. Have other qualifications according to the regulations of Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya regarding Education at Bachelor's Degree (No. 2), 2014.

- Become a traditional Thai physician in health care facilities of all levels (primary, secondary, tertiary)
- Become traditional Thai physician in other educational institutions or other establishments
- Have an independent career in Thai traditional medicine both in the country and abroad
- Study a master's degree in Thai traditional medicine or related fields
